 a. Must have at least 2 different kinds of plants/trees from this region. You may add more than 2 kinds. b. All plants/trees/ are labeled. (If you add more than 2 plants, you don't need to label the additional trees or plants. 	a. Each plant/tree is worth 10 points b. Each label is worth 2 points Total points: up to 24 points
Inside the box: LANDFORMS	
 a. Must have the correct landforms that represent the region to display in your box. (For example, you wouldn't put an ocean landform in a region box that was meant to be a mountainous region.) b. Must have landforms labeled. (Example, mountains, rolling hills, valleys, etc.) 	a. Worth 20 points b. Landform(s) labeled 2 points Total points: up to 22 points
Inside the box: Animals	
 a. Must have animals (at least 2) that are found in that region. b. Must have the animals <u>labeled</u>. 	a. Each animal is worth 10 pointsb. Each label is worth 2 points Total points: up to 24 points

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a. Project must be neatly put together. Remember, it needs to look like you're looking into the region you researched.

Take your time! Don't start gluing the materials down until you know for sure you want it in that spot. You can look at pictures from our books, pictures of the regions, or videos to refresh your memory on how things look like in your region.
